MOBILITY OF WOOD WORKERS
(JOINERS/CARPENTERS) ACROSS EUROPE
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1. Intellectual Output O1

Every partner presented their own information contained on the job profile of joiner in its own country, which was followed by an elaboration of a comparative mapping containing information about the joiner/carpenter in each of the participating countries, which was made by OCH-CFB, who is the leader of this IO1.

The consortium started the work to define a job profile with the same competencies, skills and abilities for the participating partners in the project, to facilitate the workers mobility.

Recommendations:

- Quality, safety and health.
- Preparation and organization of the work according to technical specifications.
- Preparation of machines and cutting tools. Tuning of equipment.
- Finishing knowledges to repair.
- Surface preparation.
- Maintenance equipment.
- Horizontals skills.
- Soft skills.
- Installation of wood and facing.

Consequently, partners could arrive at a common definition of Eurojoiner:

“The person, who makes, assembles and installs (tailor-made / constructive) elements based on wood and its derivatives, using hand tools, electrical hand-operated machinery and woodworking machines”.

During the meeting partners decided to use the Portuguese template to define the qualification, because is a template used by CEDEFOP.

Partners defined the activities developed by a joiner as a sequential way, a work-flow based sequence:

- Preparation and planning
- Selection (materials and machines)
- Processing
- Assembly
- Finishing
- Install on-site
- Completing work assignment

2.2nd Meeting

The second transnational meeting took place in the premises of two different Vocational Training and Education centres that are located in Stockholm. The meeting was held in 12h and 13th April 2016.

During the first day, it was celebrated in the Wood Joiner department of S:t Martin's Gymnasium.

The participation of AIDIMME in the mobility exchange project work consisted in contributing to programme planning, dissemination and evaluation and commitment to high quality learning programme, which was coordinated by TMF - Trä- och Möbelföretagen.

On June 13th and 14th EUROJOINER will have the 3th Meeting in Brussels, combined with a dissemination event through the Sectoral Social Dialogue Woodworking/Furniture in Brussels, where partners will present Eurojoiner Erasmus+ project in both events, where the Multiplier Event O1 will take place.
